Day Trek Set for October 4 to The Dalles, Dufur and Dinner at The Balch Hotel

Saturday, October 4, 2008

We have been considering a day trip in the fall — Saturday, October 4 — up the gorge to The Dalles Discovery Center, Fort Dalles and on to Dufur to see their log cabin museum and dine and tour the Balch Hotel. Items on the menu could include baked salmon, fresh fruit, bacon wrapped steak, etc. Sharon Nesbit will conduct the tour and narrate sites along the way.

The trick of course, in these days of \$4 gasoline, is to nail down soaring transportation costs. However, we think we have safely hedged on the price of a school bus. The big coaches are way beyond our budget, and we can manage with a school bus since this a short jaunt. If we can assure 20 Trekkers at \$100 each we can pay for the trip and make Troutdale Historical Society a bit of money to cover office costs, etc.

Music for First Friday will be provided by the ever popular Frank Grande and the band "Swingali" playing their Gypsy Jazz and wine tasting will be provided by Star Simon from Leaning Star Winery in Corbett.

First Friday artists will be a successful pair of sisters, Inga & Kym Ojala. With connections to the Hollywood film industry, Inga has always simply considered herself an artist. She specializes in paintings of fish and spends many hours fishing and study the outdoors, to put the realism in her paintings. Inga also enjoys carving wildlife and fish in wood, that are used in furniture and wall art. When she is diving, she studies the natural feel of the water and the fish's environment. She paints in many different mediums and adds materials such as sand and grass to the canvas and will sometimes add one of her hand-tied flies or lures to the artwork.

Inga and Kym are daughters of a famous Hollywood gunslinger Arvo Ojala and actress-model Doris Seversen, Inga was born in Seattle, Wash., and is of Finnish and Norwegian decent. Inga and Kym's father, Arvo, is a world-renowned gunslinger, working with such luminaries as Paul Newman, James Garner, James Arness, Marilyn Monroe, and Natalie Wood. But perhaps he is most famous for his work in front of as well as behind the scenes of one of the greatest television westerns, *Guns smoke*. Mr. Ojala is the man who challenges Marshall Dillon in the opening sequence of each episode.

Inga, a horse trainer and expert marksman, has worked on films as a stunt coordinator or even performed the stunts herself. She has been in many films - including parts in *The Wild Life*, *The Man with Two Brains*, *Protocol* and *Fast Times at Ridgemont High* and television programs, such as *Love Boat* and *Fantasy Island* and many more.

But in the midst of this hectic acting career remains her great love of art, which led to create Norffinn Designs, in which she can display her talents in creating murals, faux finishes, scrimshaw, leather engraving, fresco and trompe l'oeil as well as hold classes to pass on her skills to all ages this information can be seen on her website.

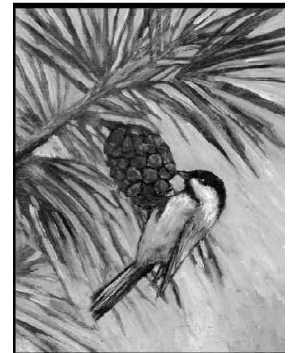
Inga's work can be seen in not only commercial establishments but also residential homes, throughout the United States. In addition she is an Art Director and Set Designer.

She also, enjoys photographing the Oregon landscapes, from which Kym creates her beautiful paintings that come to life.

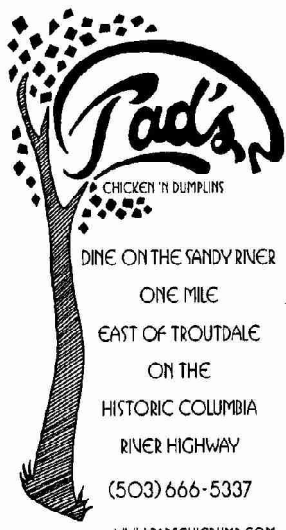

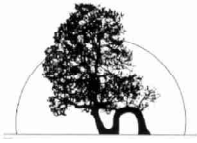

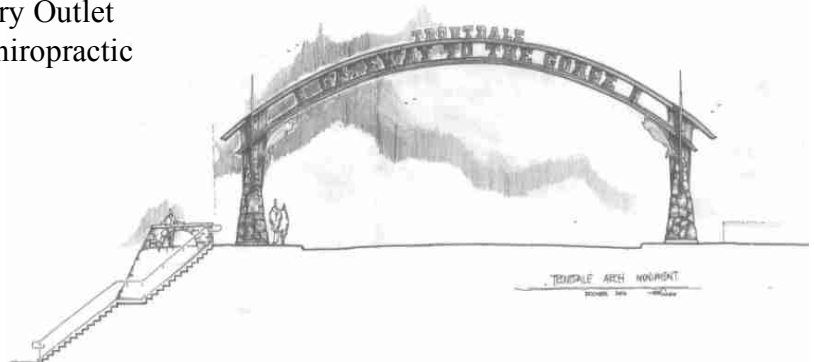
